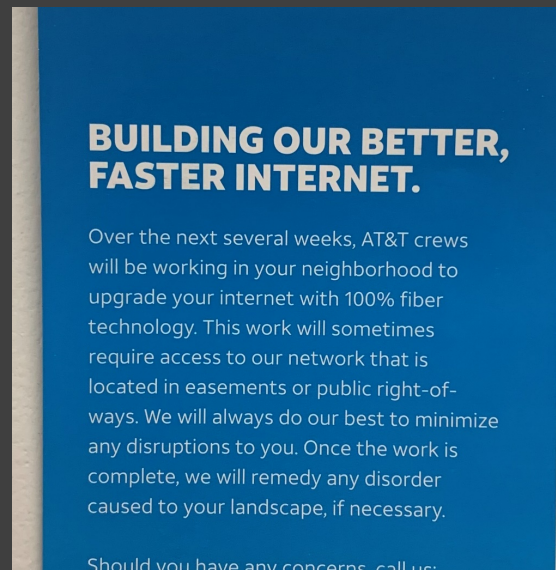


# AT&T Fiber Build



- AT&T will place door hangers, neighborhood entrance signs or yard signs to communicate the fiber build that will include a brief description of what to expect along with a phone number for questions.



# Construction Process

- AT&T contractors will use white spray paint to show proposed placement of main connection box.
- Locate company will mark utilities with paint and or flags.

	<b>White</b> proposed excavation
	<b>Fluorescent Pink</b> temporary survey markings
	<b>Red</b> electric power lines, cables, conduit and lighting cables
	<b>Yellow</b> gas, oil, steam, petroleum, or gaseous materials
	<b>Orange</b> communication, alarm or signal lines, cables or conduit
	<b>Blue</b> potable water
	<b>Purple</b> reclaimed water, irrigation and slurry lines
	<b>Green</b> sewers and drain lines





- Contractors will begin placing aerial and or buried cable in the neighborhood. Different types of machinery are used including bore machines and excavators.

Depending on design and scope of project, contractors may place pedestals, handholes and flower-pots at pre-determined locations through out the neighborhood in easement areas.





After facilities are placed AT&T Splicers will begin splicing fiber at various locations in the neighborhood.
